Rare local ghost patch set placed in auction

The Council has placed the rare Cherokee Area Council Ghost Patch on EBay (lot 7721710368). **The auction ends November 6th.** A more detailed description is given below. Check this out for a great collectible and help out the Council.

This is a lot of 7 patches and a hat pin. These were part of a set of patches that were sold in 1995 for the 75th anniversary of the Cherokee Area Council, Oklahoma. Only 75 sets were available, and the white ghost CSP was only available in the sets. This is probably the most difficult Cherokee Area Council patch to find, as usually the sets are not broken up. They also had T-shirts and belt buckles that were a part of these sets.

This set contains: white ghost CSP, regular CSP, Washita Lodge 288 flap, Camporee pocket patch (left), Scout-O-Rama pocket patch (right - the two pocket patches were designed to mount together on the pocket under the OA flap), Camp Cherokee Summer Camp pocket patch, Camp McClintock Winter Camp pocket patch, and 75th anniversary hat pin.

Besides being an extremely rare patch, this set of these patches makes a great display.

To find the auction on EBay, go to www.ebay.com and then enter the lot number in the search box. It will go immediately to the listing. You can also enter "Cherokee Area patch" in the search box. Registration on EBay is free and people who are not registered can view any auction item.
